



JC SHIRAZ

Variety:

100% Shiraz.

Vintage:

2015.

Appearance:

Deep red.

Aroma:

Blackberry and plum.

Palate:

Full-bodied and rich in dark fruit, the palate is balanced by acidity and soft tannins, giving the wine great length. The oak also plays a supporting role to the generous, ripe dark cherry and plum flavours along with a hint of white pepper.

Food pairing:

Rare eye fillet with a red wine reduction and seasonal roast vegetables.

Cellaring:

Enjoy now or until 2023.

Winemaking notes:

Grapes were hand-picked from our Jack's Block vineyard planted in 1921 and fermented in open-top fermenters. Daily hand-plunging extracted excellent tannin, yet the wine has an elegance that is characteristic of the vintage. After pressing, the wine was matured in a mixture of French and American hogsheads, most of them new.
